- + African American or Ashkenazi Jewish background
- + Use of hormone replacement therapy for more than five years
- + BRCA1 or BRCA2 mutation carrier

Prostate Screenings*

African-American Men

- + Ages 40-70

Caucasian Men

- + Ages 50-70 or starting at age 40 if family history of prostate cancer

Offerings

- + Prostate specific antigen (PSA) test and digital rectal exam (DRE)

Potential Symptoms

- + Trouble urinating
- + Lower back pain or discomfort
- + Blood in urine
- + Erectile dysfunction
